Today's Reflection: a month to unlock new levels.

Today's Reflection: there is so much in God

Even if a million men were given millions of years dedicated to studying and knowing God, they would never exhaust all of the knowledge of God. There is so much in God that our human mind can not begin to comprehend. It should be clear to us that there are depths of God that no man has known yet. The Bible said, "It is the glory of God to conceal a thing: but the honour of kings is to search out a matter." (Proverbs 25:2). Job speaking poetically said, "There is a path which no fowl knoweth, and which the vulture's eye hath not seen: The lion's whelps have not trodden it, nor the fierce lion passed by it." (Job 28:7-8). The Psalmist calls it the deep calling to the deep (Psalm 42:6).

It is for this reason that those who know this never stop pressing on to know more of God. It doesn't matter how much men have known about God, there remains so much more to be known. There is a vast measure of hidden mystery in God that is meant for our glory. Look at how Paul says it, "But we speak the wisdom of God in a mystery, even the hidden wisdom, which God ordained before the world unto our glory:" (1 Corinthians 2:7). The more we know God, the more we gain access into His wisdom. The more of God's wisdom we have in us, the more glorious our lives become.

Solomon stood out amongst the men of his day because of the amount of God's wisdom that He was granted access to. He ruled the then world, and was so rich that silver was as common as stone in Jerusalem (1 Kings 10:27). Beloved let us press on to know the Lord that we may receive of His fullness! Prayers: Lord, teach me to press into You all the more.

By much slothfulness the building decayeth; and through idleness of the hands the house droppeth through. Ecclesiastes 10:18

Today's Reflection: The best time to start is now.

If not now, when? Do you know procrastination is a major cause of failure in life? The Bible warns against slothfulness and procrastination. These two have served to destroy the lives and destinies of many people. The more the time wasted on a task, the harder it may become. A blacksmith who makes iron tools knows that the best time to strike the iron is when it is red hot. Waiting any longer only means you won't get the desired results. No man ever gets things done by staying in bed and planning for later. If you have conceived an idea, get to begin to work on it. Do not leave the idea for later, it will lose its energy in your spirit.

The Book of Romans 12:11 says "Not slothful in business; fervent in spirit; serving the Lord;". Slothful people will have things looking slow and tasting stale in their lives. When we allow things to linger and drag, we will most probably never get to achieve them. Never give into excuses, if it should be done, then let it be done by every proper means.

Excuses only produce empty lives, filled with nothing but pains and regrets. People who always give excuses never have things working for them. They will still make up excuses as to why their lives are turning out so. God's word has come to challenge and awaken us to the reality of time. The best time is now. Start that business, that project, that event plan, that scheduled prayer and word studies, etc. Saints of God, start now!

Prayers: Lord I receive the "doing" grace, I will not relent in Jesus name.

**For every house is builded by some man; but he that built all things is God.
Hebrews 3:4**

Today's Reflection: built by God.

Our lives are constantly being shaped by a lot of things that we may never have realized. Things such as our life experiences, situations, education, the media, people, the world around us, etc. Unconsciously, our lives are built by these things. Not many people know that their lives are being built by things they have no idea of. When a person's life is built wrongly, then pain, suffering, and regret will be the result.

However, for us when we became born again, we received a brand new life. The Bible tells us "Therefore if any man be in Christ, he is a new creature: old things are passed away; behold, all things are become new." (2 Corinthians 5:17). We gained the opportunity of having all things become new. However, with all things being new, we must carefully work on how our new life is built. This is why the Bible says, "And be not conformed to this world..." (Romans 12:2). God is saying to us to refuse being shaped and built by the things that are of this world, everything and anything that does not have its origin in God.

We must therefore yield ourselves to God the builder of all things. Whatever He builds endures forever, it overcomes the world, triumphing always (Ecclesiastes 3:14, 1 John 5:5, 2 Corinthians 2:14). So those who are wise commit every single part of their lives to the hands of God. They live strictly by the word of God, believing nothing else than what the Bible says. It is for this type of people that it is written: "Eye hath not seen, nor ear heard, neither have entered into the heart of man, the things which God hath prepared for them that love him." (1 Corinthians 2:9). God the builder!

Prayers: Lord, I surrender absolutely, be the sole builder of my life.

Shew me thy ways, O Lord; teach me thy paths. Psalm 25:4

Today's reflection: faith is God's way!

The ways of a person refer to how a person operates. The greatest privilege given to man is the privilege of learning the ways of God. It means people who learn the ways of God will operate like God. God taught Moses His ways because of this Moses was made a god to Pharaoh (Psalm 103:7, Exodus 7:1). Knowing this, our lifetime pursuit becomes knowing the ways of God through meditating on God's word and prayers.

Now one of the fundamental ways of God is faith. It is completely different from the ways of man. The Bible says, "But without faith it is impossible to please him: for he that cometh to God must believe that he is, and that he is a rewarder of them that diligently seek him." (Hebrews 11:6). Faith is not natural to man, it has to be received and learned (Romans 12:3). Take for example, the way of man is "seeing is believing" whilst the way of God is "believe and see" (John 11:40). Consider the following scriptures. The way of man — the people speaking to Jesus said, "Show us a miraculous sign if you want us to believe in you. What can you do?" (John 6:30, NLT). Whilst the way of God reads like this — "Then Jesus said, "Did I not tell you that if you believe, you will see the glory of God?" (John 11:40, NLT).

We should realize that faith is first the way of God, so like David, we must cry out to God to teach us this way of His. If it is Bible faith, then the source of it must be God and His word. We must therefore prioritize the reading and hearing of God's word, as faith comes by hearing (Romans 10:17). Secondly, we must engage daily in praying in the Holy Ghost for the building of our faith (Jude 20).

Prayers: Oh Lord, like the Psalmist, I cry out, teach me Your ways!

For therein is the righteousness of God revealed from faith to faith: as it is written, The just shall live by faith. Romans 1:17

Today's Reflection: you can prosper and succeed in all you do.

Paul the Apostle in our opening scripture was quoting the writing of Habbakuk, an Old Testament prophet. This was the original text, "Behold, his soul which is lifted up is not upright in him: but the just shall live by his faith." (Habakkuk 2:4). All those who have believed in the Lord Jesus for salvation have been justified (Romans 5:1). It means this scripture speaks of us.

Therefore, as believers, the only way we are to live is by faith. Just as the body lives on food and oxygen so must we live by faith. Now not just faith as a lifestyle but faith as the life we live. Consider what Paul the Apostle says about himself "I am crucified with Christ: nevertheless I live; yet not I, but Christ liveth in me: and the life which I now live in the flesh I live by the faith of the Son of God, who loved me, and gave himself for me." (Galatians 2:20). Because we too have been crucified with Christ, the life we now live is the life of faith.

A life of faith is a life that believes and lives only by what the Bible says. God told Joshua how to live a life of faith. He said to him, "Study this Book of Instruction continually. Meditate on it day and night so you will be sure to obey everything written in it. Only then will you prosper and succeed in all you do." (Joshua 1:8, NLT). This is the life of faith! The result of living by faith is that you prosper and succeed in **ALL** you do. No power in heaven and on earth can stop a life of faith, for it is the very life of God. Beloved, let us practically live a life of faith in our thoughts, words, and actions. We have overcome the world!

Prayers: Lord, I choose the life of faith forever!

Now we command you, brethren, in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ, that ye withdraw yourselves from every brother that walketh disorderly, and not after the tradition which he received of us. 2 Thessalonians 3:6

Today's Reflection: order births creation and beauty.

Before creation, the earth was in a state of chaos, disorder, and emptiness (Genesis 1:2). The Hebrew tongue in which the Book of Genesis was written refers to this state of the earth as “*tohu bohu*”. The next thing we see is the Spirit of God moving over the face of the waters. This was God’s move to bring the earth into order enabling the creation of God’s beautiful world. The result of God’s move was – “And God saw every thing that he had made, and, behold, it was very good. And the evening and the morning were the sixth day.” (Genesis 1:31).

We can now see clearly that disorder is chaos, and order is beauty. Disorder and order are words and opposites. Disorder simply means to be out of order, while order is the situation that exists when everything is in the correct or expected place or happens at the correct or expected time. Paul in writing to the Thessalonians highlighted how much disorderliness must be strongly resisted. Nothing good ever comes out of disorderliness. Be it in a person's life, business, ministry, career, academics, marriage, relationship, etc.

The Bible says “For God is not a God of disorder but of peace...” (1 Corinthians 14:33, NIV). Indeed we live in a disorderly world, where things are largely done in a disorderly manner. We must strongly resist every form of disorder. The Spirit of God that we received when we became born again is a Spirit of order. We must always insist on doing things the correct way, bringing order into every sphere of our lives like God did in the beginning.

Prayers: Lord, by Your Spirit help me to bring order into my life!

For this cause left I thee in Crete, that thou shouldest set in order the things that are wanting, and ordain elders in every city, as I had appointed thee: Titus 1:5

Today's Reflection: we are the only hope the world has.

Everything in creation since Adam sinned in the garden had continued to tend naturally towards disorder. Soon after the fall, Cain rose and killed Abel, a manifestation of the disorder in the system of the world. The disorder continued so quickly that just 10 generations after Adam, God decided to destroy the whole world with the floods that came in the days of Noah (Genesis 6&7).

Since then God's beautiful world has continued to glide steadily towards disorder till this day. However, soon it will be burnt with fire at the end of days (2 Peter 3:10). Then we will have a new heaven and new earth (Revelation 21:1). But until then, we are the only hope of order this world has. The same Spirit of God that moved over the face of the waters, in the beginning, to bring order to the earth at creation now dwells in us (Genesis 1:2, 1 Corinthians 3:16). God's will for the earth is order, an orderly world filled with God's peace. This is why the Lord Jesus taught us to pray daily that God's kingdom of righteousness, peace, and joy comes on the earth (Matthew 6:10, Romans 14:17).

So everywhere we are found things must be done orderly and correctly, in peace and joy. From our homes to our workplaces, churches, schools, communities, cities, and nations. Enforcing order in our lives and every other place always starts in the place of prayers. Constantly praying to God to cause His will that brings order to be done in our lives and in every place of our human existence (Matthew 6:10, 1 Timothy 2:1-4). We are the restorers of order on earth.

Prayers: Lord, I receive the grace to have my life and world set in order

For if by one man's offence death reigned by one; much more they which receive abundance of grace and of the gift of righteousness shall reign in life by one, Jesus Christ.) Romans 5:17

Today's Reflection: the Lord's grace is all we need for life!

God so loved the world that He gave us everything He had in Christ Jesus. This is the extent to which our Father in Heaven loves us. No matter how thoughtful we try to be, we can never comprehend the scope of the love of God for us. We may only like the Psalmist say, "what are mere mortals that you should think about them, human beings that you should care for them?" (Psalm 8:4, NLT). The giving of our Lord and Saviour to us by our Heavenly Father is the highest dimension of love that there is in the universe! (John 15:13).

The Lord Jesus came to us full of grace. The Bible says "For the law was given by Moses, but grace and truth came by Jesus Christ." (John 1:17). The Lord Jesus told Paul the Apostle "...My grace is sufficient for thee" (2 Corinthians 12:9). How amazing! It means all that we will ever need in this life is the grace of our Lord Jesus Christ! And do you know what? This grace is sufficient for us, always in superabundant supply. What a joy!

Having full confidence in the grace of our Lord Jesus Christ we can like Paul the Apostle say, "I can do all things through Christ which strengtheneth me." (Philippians 4:13). Through this abundant grace the Bible says we will reign in life by our Lord Jesus Christ (Romans 5:17). You see why we cannot but ride on the high places of this life? Beloved let us take advantage of the grace of our Lord Jesus Christ in all matters of life and godliness. Let us take advantage of this grace and labour exceedingly, until our profiting appears for the whole world to see!

Prayers: Father, I believe in the grace of my Lord Jesus Christ!

Now the parable is this: The seed is the word of God. Luke 8:11

Today's Reflection: become a sower.

There is this powerful secret that only a very few know. It is the power of words. Even amongst these few who know, only another few have mastered how to use it effectively. Words are not just sounds or a medium of communication, they have the ability to be spirit and life (John 6:63). People have not come to the full comprehension that everything that exists in this physical world came to being by spoken words. The Bible said, "Through faith we understand that the worlds were framed by the word of God, so that things which are seen were not made of things which do appear." (Hebrews 11:3).

Words are seeds the Bible tells us (Luke 8:11). This means when planted they bring forth fruits. This makes us into sowers. Every word we speak is a potential seed. It is a well-known law of life that whatever a man sows he will reap. Is this not now therefore a massive advantage for us who know this truth? It means we will get what we say. The Lord validates this truth when He said, "I tell you the truth, you can say to this mountain, 'May you be lifted up and thrown into the sea,' and it will happen. But you must really believe it will happen and have no doubt in your heart." (Mark 11:23, NLT).

Do you see why we cannot afford to say negative things or speak idle words? The Bible says, "A wholesome tongue is a tree of life..." (Proverbs 15:4). As God's children, we learn to say only good things and never to say wrong things. We train ourselves to talk like God, speaking words from God's holy word. Beloved go on sowing the seed of the right words at all times, soon you will celebrate your harvest!

Prayers: Lord, I receive wisdom to keep sowing the right words.

Walk in wisdom toward them that are without, redeeming the time. Let your speech be always with grace, seasoned with salt, that ye may know how ye ought to answer every man. Colossians 4:5-6

Today's Reflection: Grace to speak the right words.

The tongue the Bible says is one of the smallest part of the body, yet the most powerful as the power of life and death resides in the tongue. The Lord in one of His teachings to the multitude warned thus on the use of words — “For by thy words thou shalt be justified, and by thy words thou shalt be condemned.” (Matthew 12:37). Such a powerful admonishing from the Lord. This is a big message for the day we live in.

Many crises that erupted in families, relationships, organizations, and even among nations stemmed from the wrong use of words. Every man who knows how to use words wisely will eat the good fruits of it. Do you remember the Bible said “A soft answer turneth away wrath: but grievous words stir up anger.” (Proverbs 15:1). That problem would have never risen if words were used rightly. Words from parents to children, husbands to wives, bosses to employees, workers to colleagues, leaders to followers and vice-versa, etc.

Let's carefully reflect on these questions. “Do I take out time to ponder on my words before saying them? Do I talk too much when excited? Do I lose control of my words when angry?”. In your most relaxed state respond to these questions and trust the Holy Spirit to help us in the areas we find ourselves wanting. Next, we will begin to train ourselves to use kind words at all times and in all situations. This will actually take time, so let's not be discouraged when we still make mistakes in the use of our words. Keep striving until you attain mastery.

Prayers: Oh Lord I receive grace to always speak the right words.

A man's belly shall be satisfied with the fruit of his mouth; and with the increase of his lips shall he be filled. Death and life are in the power of the tongue: and they that love it shall eat the fruit thereof. Proverbs 18:20-21

Today's Reflection: eating the fruit of our words!

Many believers only pray to destroy the enemies they feel exist as humans and physical foes but they forget that their mouth and their words can become the enemies of their life. Some people left our lives and became our foes because they heard us say certain things about them that we shouldn't have said. Words can be as sharp as a butcher's knife and when we don't place caution on them, we will injure a lot of people and kill a lot of important relationships.

God's word tells us that there is something as the fruit of our mouths (Proverbs 18:20). We can enjoy the blessings of speaking awesome and blissful words. Do you know you can say things that will make people forever love and care for you? Even so, you can say words that will make people never help you. Our meditation today should be directed towards the words we speak. Do not allow words to come out of your mouth unconsciously and incautiously, remember when they're released, they can't be taken back.

Saints, we can learn to practice the following; the use of kind words instead of harsh ones. The use of humble remarks when speaking about ourselves. In speaking to older people or people in positions of authority the use of words that convey honour is great wisdom. Deciding to be quiet when angry or overtly excited can be golden. Finally, the ability to apologize quickly when we are wrong and the art of saying "thank you" can predispose us to unthinkable levels of favour.

Prayers: Oh Lord, I receive the grace to always speak the right words.

Brethren, I count not myself to have apprehended: but this one thing I do, forgetting those things which are behind, and reaching forth unto those things which are before, Philippians 3:13

Today's Reflection: Choose wisdom.

We live in a day and time now where people's hearts and attention are divided on so many matters. Their minds keep going over diverse issues uncontrollably, often leading to confusion, worries, fear, depression, mental fatigue, and exhaustion amongst many others. This should not be so. Of course, things will not go well when people have the wrong approach to life.

You see the Bible is not a religious book for Christians, no! It is the textbook for life. It tells us what will work in life and what will not. It informs accurately on all matters of life. Now according to the Bible, man was not created to have his heart set on many things. If he does, trouble will ensue. In this popular Bible story, consider Martha's experience and what the Lord Jesus told her. "Martha was worried about all that had to be done. Finally, she went to Jesus and said, "Lord, doesn't it bother you that my sister has left me to do all the work by myself? Tell her to come and help me!" The Lord answered, "Martha, Martha! You are worried and upset about so many things, but only one thing is necessary. Mary has chosen what is best, and it will not be taken away from her."" (Luke 10:40-42, CEV).

Friends we were designed for one thing, which is to SEEK GOD (Matthew 6:33). The Bible tells us thus about King Uzziah "...as long as he sought the LORD, God made him to prosper." (2 Chronicles 26:5). That's wisdom! This takes away all the stress out of life and gives every other good thing of life as a reward. Choose to live like this!

Prayers: Lord, teach me to live like this for the rest of my life.

He staggered not at the promise of God through unbelief; but was strong in faith, giving glory to God; Romans 4:20

Today's Reflection: stay believing!

You see, it is not that people don't believe, it is that they do not just believe consistently. To stagger means to walk or move unsteadily as if about to fall. This is a picture of so many people's faith. This kind of faith actually gets nothing from God. The Bible says, "But when you ask, you must believe and not doubt, because the one who doubts is like a wave of the sea, blown and tossed by the wind. That person should not expect to receive anything from the Lord. Such a person is double-minded and unstable in all they do." (James 1:6-8, NIV).

Nothing has crippled the journey of people in life like a consistent mixture of doubt and belief. Father Abraham, who is the Bible model of faith, showed us what having faith should look like. See this Bible account about Father Abraham – "Even when there was no reason for hope, Abraham kept hoping—believing that he would become the father of many nations. For God had said to him, "That's how many descendants you will have!" And Abraham's faith did not weaken, even though, at about 100 years of age, he figured his body was as good as dead—and so was Sarah's womb." (Romans 4:18-19, NLT).

Beloved, we cannot afford to be double-minded and unstable in the things we claim to believe. God wants us to believe at once and never doubt. The Bible says "For all of God's promises have been fulfilled in Christ with a resounding "Yes!" And through Christ, our "Amen" (which means "Yes") ascends to God for his glory." (2 Corinthians 2:20, NIV). Our faith is such a powerful and unstoppable weapon. We must, however, hold on to the very end. We see you standing strong in faith until all the will of God is done.

Prayers: Lord, I receive grace to stand strong in faith forever!

Today's Reflection: a daily supply of life

Man is spirit, soul, and body. All of these three parts of our being are interconnected. People have many times wrongly partitioned these three parts as though they run independently. Take for example, a person may be hypertensive in the body, yet the cause of this sickness is rooted in the soul. Do you see why we must be holistic in understanding ourselves?

It is not uncommon to see many spiritual brothers and sisters neglect their bodies in a bid to build a strong spirit. They turn all their attention to the growth and well being of their spirit man, while their bodies get steadily worn out. They have forgotten that it is their bodies that permit them to be here on earth. The moment the body can no longer cope, death comes marking the end of their earthly existence. You see, a dead man cannot serve God nor do the work of ministry. We must learn wisdom.

With the foregoing in mind, we must prioritize praying for our mortal bodies. As Christians, we have the massive advantage of the Holy Spirit living in our physical bodies. Now one of the cardinal blessings of the Holy Spirit living in our bodies is that the Holy Spirit can supply spiritual life to our bodies. We must learn how this works. It starts by knowing that it works. The next thing is to believe in it. We should therefore include this in our daily prayer and confessions. Become conscious of this and draw strength from the Holy Spirit for our physical bodies. It works powerfully!

Prayer: Lord, by Your Spirit supply life daily to my body.

Now Elisha was fallen sick of his sickness whereof he died. And Joash the king of Israel came down unto him, and wept over his face, and said, O my father, my father, the chariot of Israel, and the horsemen thereof. 2 Kings 13:14

Today's Reflection: knowledge is key!

Have you observed that people turn their attention to their bodies only when they become sick? Especially on this side of the world. People just keep using their bodies without any thought of it's well being. Unfortunately many drove their bodies to the extreme until they broke down permanently. Imagine a car that is being used with no appropriate servicing and maintenance plan. Soon there may just be an engine knock and of course, a knocked engine can not be fixed.

Friends, you see what makes for a strong and healthy spirit is different from what makes for a strong and healthy body. It doesn't matter how anointed a person is, if he or she does not take care of his or her body the result will always be a breakdown in health. As seen in our opening verse, Elisha was one of the most anointed prophets in the Bible, yet he took ill and died. The Bible said he had fallen sick of his sickness whereof he died.

Just providing food for the body can never be enough. We need to be enlightened about what makes for a healthy body. If we do not invest in having a healthy body, we will have nothing to reap. Thus we must be students of Health Science and Body Wellness. People perish for lack of knowledge the Bible tells us. We should spend time learning about the right kinds of food to eat, learn about exercise, rest, body-mind relationship, body refueling, etc. We should strive to be literate about the matter of the health of our bodies.

Prayers: Lord, give me wisdom to seek knowledge about my health.

GLOBAL MISSIONS WEEK DAY 2: THE GOSPEL WE PREACH

For I delivered unto you first of all that which I also received, how that Christ died for our sins according to the scriptures; And that he was buried, and that he rose again the third day according to the scriptures:
1 Corinthians 15:34

Today's Reflection: the simplicity that is in Christ.

It is important to have a clear understanding of the gospel we preach so that we can convey its message effectively. The Bible tells us that the gospel is God's power for the salvation of people (Romans 1:16). Yet it is only an accurate gospel message that is able to save people. When the message is wrong, there can be no salvation. It is therefore important to have an accurate account from scripture as regards this message of salvation.

Paul, in telling us what the gospel message is all about writes thus, "Let me now remind you, dear brothers and sisters, of the Good News I preached to you before. You welcomed it then, and you still stand firm in it. It is this Good News that saves you if you continue to believe the message I told you—unless, of course, you believed something that was never true in the first place. I passed on to you what was most important and what had also been passed on to me. Christ died for our sins, just as the Scriptures said. He was buried, and he was raised from the dead on the third day, just as the Scriptures said." (1 Corinthians 15:1-4, NLT).

That is the pure and simple gospel message. That whosoever believes that Christ died for our sins, was buried and rose from the dead on the third day receives the gift of salvation. This is the gospel that saves, this is the gospel we preach! Saints of God, this is the simplicity of the gospel, tell everyone about it just as the Bible says it!

Prayers: Father, may we not be corrupted from the simplicity in Christ.

And he commanded us to preach unto the people, and to testify that it is he which was ordained of God to be the Judge of quick and dead. Acts 10:42

Today's Reflection: we cannot be stopped.

You see, beloved, we have received a command from our Lord to preach unto the people. There is therefore no force in heaven or earth that can stop this! We will forever preach this gospel unhindered to people all over the world. The command we receive from the Lord Jesus is superior to any law in any nation of the earth. Nothing can stop us, not even the forces of persecution, violence, terrorism, witchcraft, satanism, and the like can dare! The gospel has been preached for over 2,000 years and it will be preached forever until the Lord returns.

We must realize that there is nothing stopping us. The opposition to the gospel may appear as giants, wielding the weapon of fear, yet like Goliath of Gath, they will forever fall flat before the church of Christ. We are absolutely unstoppable. Not even the harsh economy of the day can stop us. We will print God's words in billions of copies for free, organize mammoth crusades, take over the airwaves and media, and build churches all over the world, just name it. Every avenue to preach unto the people will be exploited.

Beloved, our predecessors, Christians who lived hundreds and thousands of years before us gave it all it took. Even to their very blood. We cannot do it differently, we must give the preaching of the gospel all it takes. We will love not our lives even unto death. We will use the last dimes in our pockets in preaching this gospel. It is the Master's command, we will execute it at all costs! We are God's great end-time army!

Prayers: Lord, we will forever depend on Your grace to stand for You!

Let your light so shine before men, that they may see your good works, and glorify your Father which is in heaven. Matthew 5:16

Today's Reflection: they will rejoice in my light.

The Lord Jesus made a very remarkable statement about Himself when He said, "As long as I am in the world, I am the light of the world." (John 9:5). Is this not true about us in this day? The Lord said to us "Ye are the light of the world. A city that is set on a hill cannot be hid." (Matthew 5:14). Paul the apostle further reiterated this when he said, "That ye may be blameless and harmless, the sons of God, without rebuke, in the midst of a crooked and perverse nation, among whom ye shine as lights in the world;" (Philippians 2:15).

We are the only source of light the world has now. You see why we must shine. Without us, the world will be covered in gross darkness. We are to let our light shine before men. Our lights are for men, so we must be deliberate about shining before them. Speaking about John the Baptist, the Lord said, "He was a burning and a shining light: and ye were willing for a season to rejoice in his light." (John 5:35). People rejoiced in the light of John! We provide solutions to problems, feed the hungry, clothe the naked, heal the sick, and deliver the oppressed in the name of the Lord Jesus! This is how we shine as light!

Prayers: Father, in the name of Jesus, I shine as light!

Heal the sick, cleanse the lepers, raise the dead, cast out devils: freely ye have received, freely give. Matthew 10:8

Today's Reflection: we are all they have.

The gospel we received is a problem solving gospel. God wants a good life for every person, this is why He scripted out a plan for our salvation. The church is God's solution ground on the face of the earth as it were. All of God's goodness and goodwill towards men is channeled through the church. It is therefore important that we are aware of this and take full responsibility for providing solutions to the needs and problems of men.

The earthly ministry of our Lord Jesus was centered around problem solving (Acts 10:38). This is why the multitudes kept thronging Him as He always proffered solutions to their problems. Were they sick, He healed them, were they disabled or physically impaired, He restored abilities, were they oppressed by demons, He cast out their devils, were they hungry, He fed them. He provided answers to their questions and showed empathy when they suffered.

We must realize that as believers, we are the continuation of the earthly ministry of the Lord Jesus (John 20:21). Problem solving is our responsibility, just as the Lord did in the day of His flesh. The Lord Jesus never turned a blind eye to people's problems. This is what the church must be in this day and time. We cannot have genuine solutions to the world's problems and not have nations flowing into our churches. We cannot continue to preach a gospel that is bereft of solutions to people's problems. There is always something we can do about the conditions of men. We can intercede on their behalf, show them compassion in their sufferings, provide for their needs, become their source of joy, and ultimately bring them to know the Lord.

Prayers: Father, open my eyes to see myself as a solution to my world.

And when they had prayed, the place was shaken where they were assembled together; and they were all filled with the Holy Ghost, and they spake the word of God with boldness. Acts 4:31

Today's Reflection: we will give ourselves to prayer!

Prayer is not just a practice for the spiritual person, it is a practice of the wise. It is the most effective weapon given to men to get things done on earth. The Bible says, "...The heartfelt and persistent prayer of a righteous man (believer) is able to accomplish much [when put into action and made effective by God—it is dynamic and can have tremendous power]." (James 5:16, AMP).

It is remarkable to know that the enemy is helpless when we pray in the will of God. The force of prayers makes us unstoppable in the preaching of the gospel. This was the weapon the apostles of the Lord Jesus used in their days. Our opening verse is one of such accounts. Now this was the effect of their prayers, "And with great power gave the apostles witness of the resurrection of the Lord Jesus: and great grace was upon them all." (Acts 4:33). Prayers always work! No wonder all the news headlines of their days buzzed with their gospel exploits. One of such headlines read like this, "These that have turned the world upside down are come hither also" (Acts 17:6). All of these were owed to prayers.

In our days we will use this weapon like never before. We will pray down great grace upon our lives until the whole world hears our witness of Christ. Beloved, the onus is upon us, if we will just pray some more, we will see the salvation of our God reign in the earth. In every city and nation, the gospel of our Lord Jesus will be preached with remarkable success. Saints let's give ourselves to prayers.

Prayers: Lord, pour upon us the Spirit of grace and supplication.

While the bridegroom tarried, they all slumbered and slept. And at midnight there was a cry made, Behold, the bridegroom cometh; go ye out to meet him. Matthew 25:5-6

Today's Reflection: we stay alert and sober!

Each passing day brings us closer to the Lord's return. Soon the church of Christ in the earth will be raptured. It will happen suddenly. The Bible says, "In a moment, in the twinkling of an eye, at the last trump: for the trumpet shall sound, and the dead shall be raised incorruptible, and we shall be changed." (1 Corinthians 15:52). It will be such a glorious event! Children of God all over the world who are still alive at this time will be caught up in the clouds to meet with the Lord in the air and so shall we ever be with the Lord (1 Thessalonians 4:17).

Even as we await the Lord's return, we must heed the warning from the scriptures. The Bible says, "While the bridegroom tarried, they all slumbered and slept. And at midnight there was a cry made, Behold, the bridegroom cometh; go ye out to meet him." (Matthew 25:5-6). This was a parable the Lord told us about His return. A very striking caution as we anticipate this return is one against slumber and sleep. To slumber and sleep means to lose the sense of alertness in waiting for the Lord's return.

In response to this caution, the apostle Paul counsels us thus, "So be on your guard, not asleep like the others. Stay alert and be clearheaded. ...let us who live in the light be clearheaded, protected by the armor of faith and love, and wearing as our helmet the confidence of our salvation." (1 Thessalonians 5:6&8, NLT). We must not allow ourselves to be drunken by the cares of life which causes people to lose their spiritual alertness. Saints let's stay alert!

Prayers: Lord, do not let me sleep like others do!

And call upon me in the day of trouble: I will deliver thee, and thou shalt glorify me. Psalm 50:15

Today's Reflection: God assures us of deliverance.

God never fails to show up for His children. Are you faced with any challenge or pressing circumstances? Do you have “Pharaoh” and his host chasing after you while you are confronted by the Red Sea? Are you being bedeviled by unfavorable conditions of life? Be of good cheer, God sends His message of deliverance to everyone who calls out to Him. You will emerge victorious from trying situations in Jesus name.

Listen to God’s word to you this day in Isaiah 43:2 “When thou passest through the waters, I will be with thee; and through the rivers, they shall not overflow thee: when thou walkest through the fire, thou shalt not be burned; neither shall the flame kindle upon thee.” The word of God is proof of God’s commitment to us because He honors His word above all His name. Psalm 138:2 “...for thou hast magnified thy word above all thy name.” Thus, we can hold on to God’s unfailing words as our guarantee for safety and deliverance.

As you go through your day, your week, this month, and the year at large, hold on to this unfailing truth, whoever calls upon the name of the Lord shall be saved. Your deliverance is here and your deliverance is sure. What are you supposed to do? Engage the altar of consistent prayers, worship, and praises. This invokes the mighty power of God into your situation. You will be amazed how your story becomes a major testimony. Do not let your situation defeat you by introducing fear, discouragement, and frustration. If you don’t give up, the devil will never win!

I write unto you, little children, because your sins are forgiven you for his name's sake. 1 John 2:12

Today's reflection: who dares accuse us...

Every unrighteousness is a sin and every sinner a debtor the Bible says (1 John 5:17, Matthew 6:12). Now the sentence of sin has been set eternally, "The soul that sinneth, it shall die..." (Ezekiel 18:20). The wages of sin is death Paul the Apostle stated (Romans 6:23) and nothing will be changing this. We are to know also that "...all have sinned, and come short of the glory of God" (Romans 3:23). The Bible says, "...There is none righteous, no, not one" (Romans 3:10). It therefore means all of mankind are debtors before God, having to pay the death penalty.

Now thanks be to God, for His incomprehensible love for mankind. He sent His Son Jesus to pay the price for our sins (Isaiah 53:1-12). The Lord Jesus died for us all taking upon Himself the death penalty. We are now at this point, "Who dares accuse us whom God has chosen for his own? No one—for God himself has given us right standing with himself." (Romans 8:33, NLT). In our appreciation of the boundless love of God, we now live in total obedience to the one who has graciously forgiven all our iniquities and delivered us from death.

Prayers: Lord thank You for forgiving all my sins.

Therefore being justified by faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ: Romans 5:1

Today's Reflection: thank You, Lord...

What we received in Christ Jesus is beyond the forgiveness of sin. It is our sincere prayer that our eyes be opened more and more to see the light of our salvation. With our sins being forgiven because of God's kindness, He further blessed us with justification. Everyone of us who has believed in the Lord Jesus for the salvation of our souls is a recipient of this blessing (Romans 5:1).

The Bible tells us that Christ became our substitute. This is how Scripture says it – “For he hath made him to be sin for us, who knew no sin; that we might be made the righteousness of God in him.” (2 Corinthians 5:21). This means that our sin was transferred and inputted on the Lord in His sacrificial death. With this in the sight of God, we are now completely innocent. God being an eternally Righteous Judge can now only declare us innocent! In the sight of God, it is as though we have never sinned before. This is the wonderful blessing of the Gospel!

This is why we cannot but love the LORD our God with all our hearts, with all our souls, with all our minds, and with all our strength! Beloved, do not allow anything in this life to steal this truth from you. That moment you made the Lord Jesus the Owner and Saviour of your life, you were declared innocent from that time on. Never allow the enemy to tie you down with chains of guilt. There can be no condemnation for us in Christ Jesus (Romans 8:1). All we do now is to steadfastly look up to the Lord Jesus, enjoying a life of righteousness and true holiness forever and ever!

Prayers: Lord, thank You for declaring me innocent!

Likewise also the cup after supper, saying, This cup is the new testament in my blood, which is shed for you. Luke 22:20

Today's Reflection: the Old Covenant is abrogated

Oh, how we love the Lord! No one in this life can ever love us the way He does. On a day like this over 2,000 years ago, the Lord had His last supper before going to the cross. He had it together with His disciples in a very touching fellowship where they sang a hymn, sharing the Master's last few moments with Him until His death.

The Last Supper was no ordinary meal the Lord shared with His disciples. It was on that table that the Old Covenant was abrogated, abolished, annulled, and came to an end. It was the end of the law! (Romans 10:4). The Lord declared a New Covenant in His blood that was based on grace and truth (John 1:17). What a joy! Because the Lord Jesus was now assuming the office of our spiritual High Priest then the law must change. The Bible says, "For when the priesthood is changed, the law must be changed also. ...The former regulation is set aside because it was weak and useless (for the law made nothing perfect), and a better hope is introduced, by which we draw near to God." (Hebrews 7:12, 18&19, NIV). Praise God forevermore!

Beloved, now that the law that condemns us is no more, we can now draw near unto God having no sense of guilt or condemnation. This is how the Bible says it, "let us draw near to God with a sincere heart and with the full assurance that faith brings, having our hearts sprinkled to cleanse us from a guilty conscience and having our bodies washed with pure water." (Hebrews 10:22). Sin can never be a problem any more as it has been taken away (John 1:29). All that is left for us now is to enjoy our new life of righteousness and true holiness (Ephesians 4:24)

Prayers: Thank You, Lord Jesus, our eternal High Priest.

For whosoever shall call upon the name of the Lord shall be saved. Romans 10:13

Today's Reflection: Jesus Christ our Saviour

What a day to begin our prayer fest for March. It's Good Friday 2024! On this day many years ago our Lord Jesus was crucified. He died for us. As sinners, the death sentence from the eternal realm of justice was looming over us. The sentence reads thus – “The soul that sinneth, it shall die” (Ezekiel 18:20). Now that we all have sinned and fallen short of the glory of God (Romans 3:23), the sentence must be served. It doesn't matter how sorry an offender is before the law court, the law must take its course and the appropriate sentence served. This was our case before God's eternal court of justice.

If this death was just a physical one, the kind that happens when a person stops breathing, it would have been ok. The death sentence spoken here is an endless one. An eternal separation from God and His goodness, in a place of unthinkable suffering. It was from this gruesome sentence that the Lord Jesus our Saviour came to save us from. The Bible said, “For Christ's love compels us, because we are convinced that one died for all, and therefore all died.” (2 Corinthians 5:14). The Lord served the sentence on our behalf so that we can go free (Isaiah 53:5-12). In this light we pray!

1. Lord Jesus, thank You for dying for my sins and taking the penalty of it on my behalf. Isaiah 53:5
2. Lord Jesus, because You died, I have also died to sin, sin will never have dominion over me! Romans 6:2&14
3. Lord Jesus because of Your sacrifice for me, I am free from sin and cannot sin as Your seed now lives in me. Romans 6:7&18, 1 John 3:9

Therefore we are buried with him by baptism into death: that like as Christ was raised up from the dead by the glory of the Father, even so we also should walk in newness of life. Romans 6:4

Today's Reflection: United with Christ

Beloved, never allow this truth to slip from you. Because we believed in the Lord Jesus, in the sight of God everything that happened to the Lord happened to us (Romans 6:4, 2 Corinthians 5:14, Galatians 2:20). The Lord Jesus represented us in the case of the law of sin and death that was against us. So the death of the Lord Jesus was our death, His burial our burial, and His resurrection our resurrection.

After the Lord's crucifixion, His body was laid in a grave. It is in this similitude that we were baptized. The Bible says, "For we died and were buried with Christ by baptism. And just as Christ was raised from the dead by the glorious power of the Father, now we also may live new lives." (Romans 6:4, NLT). This is remarkable! What we have is now a new life in Christ Jesus.
